Our Neuroscience Scholars Program is a 1-2-year mentored summer research training program designed to prepare rising and current undergraduates from local Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and local Under-represented in Biomedical Research (URBR) programs for graduate school and STEM careers. The program also provides high school students from Baltimore City Public Schools with research experiences to enhance their journey towards college as STEM majors.

Program Highlights:

- 5-week mentored summer research experience working on an individualized summer research project
- Summer stipend
- Continued access to scientific mentors throughout academic year
- Partnership with YouthWorks and Kahlert Institute for Addiction Medicine
